




Magnificent Michigan Sunday-Friday June 20- June 25, 2021

The name says it all- Magnificent Michigan. This tour is going to take you to some of the most amazing, majestic and awe-inspiring places that Michigan has to offer. Our tour begins later on Sunday morning as we travel north to Manitowoc where we will board the S.S. Badger for crossing Lake Michigan. Enjoy games, movies, satellite television or just strolling around on deck during the journey, we will be dining on board the S.S. Badger. Upon docking in Ludington, MI we will be checking into a local hotel for one night. The evening is yours to enjoy and relax.



Monday- (B,D) Enjoy breakfast at the hotel before departing Gaylord, MI. Lunch in downtown Gaylord is on your own but forewarning your having a big dinner tonight. This afternoon we will be visiting the Call of the Wild Museum & Gift Shop. Enjoy an exciting and educational trip through the Call of the Wild! Magnificent displays of native wildlife will enhance the time learning about the behavior and habitat of these creatures. Hear the wolves howl and the elk bugle while learning about early



Michigan history. We continue the nature theme as we will be checking into Thunder Bay Resort this afternoon. Experience riding aboard horse drawn carriages, “over the river and through the woods” where we will be viewing elk in their natural surroundings. Learn about these regal creatures from your on-board guide. Stopping off at the

Elk Antler Log Cabin, enjoy a superb 5-course gourmet meal prepared for you on 100-year old wood cook stoves. Enjoy a glass of wine from Stoney Acres winery as you listen to humorous tales of Thunder Bays early years.

Tuesday- (B,L,D) Enjoy breakfast at the resort and a stroll around the grounds before departing mid-morning for Charlevoix. Castle Farms, built in 1918, is a beautiful French Renaissance Castle with soaring towers, stone buildings and sweeping gardens of European design. Enjoy the many collections of castles, toys and WW1 artifacts along with the outdoor model railroad featuring more than 70 G-scale trains on 2,500 feet of track. Lunch at Castle Farms before departing for Mackinaw Island. After crossing the



Mighty Mack Bridge we will board Shepler's Ferry for the Island. Check into the Lake View Hotel for a two night stay on this enchanting island. Enjoy dinner at the Yankee Rebel Tavern and the evening is yours.

Wednesday- (B,L) Wake up to breakfast at the hotel, followed by a horse drawn carriage ride of Mackinac Island. Visit awesome views, hear island history and check out the possibilities for exploring. The grand lady await us for lunch as we will be dining at the Grand Hotel's, Grand Buffet Lunch. Take some time afterwards to browse around the grounds before venturing back downtown. The afternoon and evening are yours to experience as you would like. Shopping, sightseeing, biking, hiking or relaxing, many options to enjoy.



Thursday- (B,L,D) Enjoy breakfast before heading to the ferry for our return trip to mainland Michigan. Today we will be traveling to the magnificent Tahquamenon Falls, a stroll along solid surface walkways will bring you to the thundering falls that



you will surely hear well before you see. Feel the spray of the falls from the viewing platform and get some amazing photos. Lunch will be at the Tahquamenon Falls Brewery & Pub. After browse through the wonderful gift shop on the grounds. Next, we travel on to Munising where we will go on

the classic Pictured Rock Cruise. View brilliantly colored cliffs, sea caves and pristine beaches. See formations that have been delighting guests for years, lovers leap, Indian head, miners castle and chapel rock. This evening we will be staying at the Holiday Inn Express that overlooks beautiful Lake Superior. After dinner at a local restaurant make sure you relax outside and enjoy the view.



Friday- (B,L) Breakfast at the hotel before we begin our journey home. On the way we will be stopping at “Kitch-iti-kipi” Michigan’s largest spring. It is 200’ in diameter,



42’ deep and delivers 16,000 gallons of crystal-clear water per minute. You can ride the hand wheel operated raft for an amazing view of the spring. Take a moment or two to read about the lore of spring. Lunch will be at the Swedish

Pantry. Then we continue on to home. Relax and reflect on the amazing time you had exploring Magnificent Michigan.
